

Devaun Park Golf Cart and Low Speed Vehicle Rules

Effective: September 1, 2022

The Devaun Park Community Association Board of Aldermen approved Golf Cart and Low Speed Vehicle (LSV) rules on August 24, 2022.

Notwithstanding any provisions of the Brunswick County Golf Cart Ordinance (CHAPTER 1-7, ARTICLE V, AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS ON PUBLIC STREETS) that are applicable to Devaun Park roads, the DPBOA adopts the following rules.

1. Golf carts and other LSVs (as defined by the North Carolina Department of Transportation) may be operated in Devaun Park by persons having a legal drivers license. All other operators must be accompanied in the vehicle by a licensed adult aged 18 or over.
2. Golf carts and LSVs may ONLY be operated at posted speed limits or below (currently 15 mph).
3. Operation of golf carts and LSVs is permitted ONLY on paved roads, alleyways, crushed stone or other hard surfaces. Soft or grassy common areas are off limits to golf carts and LSVs except for brief parking or movement onto hard surfaces for the sole purpose of safe navigation.
4. All golf carts and LSVs operated in Devaun Park must be electric powered vehicles. Gas powered vehicles are prohibited.
5. Operation of golf carts and LSVs is prohibited between sunset and sunrise unless the vehicle has functioning headlights and tail/brake lights.
6. It is recommended that owners or renters of golf carts and LSVs operated in Devaun Park carry bodily injury and property damage liability insurance as a rider on their homeowner's insurance or as a stand-alone policy.
